Outpatient Study Rates

Levels 1 \$85 per hour or fraction of an hour	Level 2 \$95 per hour or fraction of an hour	Level 3 \$105 per hour or fraction of an hour	Level 4 \$115 per hour or fraction of an hour
Nursing interventions needed "average" of 15 - 30 minutes for every hour. Examples: Routine vital signs and EKG. Occasional (no more often than q 2 hour) sample collection. Routine patient reinforcement of education.	Nursing Interventions needed "average 30 – 45 minutes for every hour. Interventions may be by one nurse only or may include >1 nursing personnel, but total nursing time per hour averages 30 - 45 minutes for every hour. Equal to 2.7 per patient hours Examples: Frequent vital signs and/or site checks. Frequent (no more often than q 15 minute) sample collection. Complex specimen processing that may or may not be occurring concurrently with sample collection, Complex patient education, medication administration.	Interventions involve more than one nursing personnel where ratio of nurse to patient may be 1:2. Equals to 4.0 hours per patient Examples: Constant vital sign monitoring/ site checks / blood glucose monitoring Frequent sample collection more often than q 15 minutes. Procedures require special specimen collection + specimen processing, medication administration. Subject with significant cognitive, emotional, health problems that require ongoing support, IV infusions that require nurses to do monitoring and or observations.	Interventions involve more than one nursing personnel where ratio of nurse to patient may be 1:1. 7- 8 per patient hours Examples: Complex/atypical setting for complex study such as Insulin clamp procedure in addition to: Phase I drug infusion, titrating research medication, complex vital signs; PK's q 7 min; frequent EKG's, complex orders, flow checks IV access. Complex blood or specimen processing or special handling that may need to occur concurrently with specimen collection.

Inpatient Study Rates

24 hour stay with 1 to 1 Nursing Support for 7 to 4 hours (Level 1)	\$1200 per/night, plus Medical Center bed rate at \$1574
24 hour stay with 1 to 1 Nursing Support for 11 to 8 hours (Level 2)	\$1400 per/night, plus Medical Center bed rate at \$1574
24 hour stay with 1 to 1 Nursing Support for 23 to 12 hours (Level 3)	\$1700 per/night, plus Medical Center bed rate at \$1574
24 hours 1 to 1 Nursing Support (Level 4)	\$2000 per/night, plus Medical Center bed rate at \$1574

Nursing acuity is the amount of time required for research data collection and routine patient: psych and social needs, family intervention by a registered nurse.

Criteria for calculating Level 1 - 4 acuity categories includes:

Direct patient care totals needed for procedures, data collection, frequency of specimen collection, patient care and patient needs.

Indirect patient care is protocol set up, implementation phase, and operational phase.

Hours per patient day (HPPD) for inpatients and outpatients is rated on a scale of 1 - 4

Minimal Intensity Level 1 = 1 - 2.9 HPPD 1:3 or 1:4

Minimal Intensity Level 2 = 3 - 6.9 HPPD 1:3

Moderate Intensity Level 3 = 7 - 9 HPPD 1:2

High Intensity Level 4 = 9 HPPD 1:1
